The **Bishop's Committee Minutes for August and September** for those meetings were approved.

The Treasurer's Report: Jim presented the Summary of St. Mark's Finances — 10/16/2017, St. Mark's Finance Report 2017, and the 2017 Operating Bills and Outreach Summary. Jim reviewed St. Mark's Finances Summary. Net Operating Year to Date shows a small positive balance of \$611.83, but it will be larger once the Sagen gift funds are replaced with funds from the St. Mark's DIF (money spent for our part of the parking area paving project with the Montesano Church of God). Kevin moved to draw \$3,564 from the St. Mark's DIF for replacement of the Sagen fund for future outreach use. The motion was seconded and carried. We have done a lot of outreach items as part of closing St. John's operating account and also St. Mark's Outreach year to date—over \$17,000 in total! All bills are paid current.
